the Legislature, entitled, "an act for establishing
the mode of granting the lands now vacant in this
State, and for allowing a commutation to be re-
-ceived for some lands that have been granted,"
passed the 19th day of February, 1791; We have
granted, and by these presents do grant unto James
Bradley his heirs and assigns, a plantation or
tract of land containing one hundred and
seventy seven acres surveyed for him 1st day July 1819
situate in the district of Gunville on both sides
of Enore river, bounded by Rays line running
S. E. by Benson, line S. W. ditto line N. W.
