Granted bargained and sold and by these pres-  
-ents do grant bargain and sell unto the said  
Lewis Bridges all that piece parcel or tract  
of Land supposed to contain one hundred  
acres in the same more or less being part of  
a tract of Land originally granted to Joseph  
Langston, Sitsate in Greenville District at the foot  
of Parson mountain on the waters of Rudy River -  
beginning at a stake corner on the original  
line of Jas. Langston old survey next to the  
mountain running thence South Thirty degrees
