 That I Thomas Griffin of Greenville District
 and State aforesaid for an in consideration of the
 sum of fifty dollars to me in hand paid by Sam-
 uel Dyer of the District and State aforesaid —
 have granted bargained sold and released and by these
 presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said
 Samuel Dyer a plantation or tract of land lying
 and being situate in the district and state aforesaid
 - said on Stoney Creek waters of Reedy River it
 being a part of the lands belonging to the Estate of
 James Scarborough Deceased and sold at the sale
 of his lands it being a part of Lot No. 16. begin-
 ning on Ro 3x Runs N 65 E 55, 25 to a stake 3x then S 45.
 E 19 to a stake 3x S 55 W 53 to Ro 3x N 54 W to the big
 - river including one hundred acres together with
 all and singular the rights, members hereditamly
 and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any
 wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all
 and singular the premises before mentioned unto the
 said Samuel Dyer and I do hereby bind my self, my
 heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and defend
 all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto
 the said Samuel Dyer, his heirs and assigns forever ag-
 -ainst my self and my heirs and against every other
 person whosoever lawfully claiming or to claim
 the same or any part thereof In witness whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 24th day
 of February 1817, signed and delivered in presence
 of Asa Reed Thomas Griffin Seal
