Know all men by these presents that I Varday
McBee of North Carolina, for and in consideration
= on of the convenience of laying off a Street of 28'
in width in the South East Square of the village
of Greenville running parallel with Main Street from
Avenue Street which Street is called Brown Street in
the enlarged Plan of the Village as laid off by the said
Varday do hereby convey Relinquish & quit claim
unto Jeremiah Cleveland, of Greenville Village in
the said State of South Carolina, all or any Right, tit-
le or claim I have in & to the Lot or any part of
a certain Lot known & distinguished in said Plan
& in the said South East Square as No 10 being
the back of the front Lot, on which the said
Jeremiah Cleveland now resides the size of which
Lot No 10 is represented in said Plan to be 140 feet
fronting Brown Street & running 200 feet back
In testimony whereof I have set my hand & seal
at Greenville the 1st day of January 1823.
