 or assigns shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto
 the said James Pickett his heirs Executors Administrators or
 The full and just sum of Ten Thousand four hundred dollars
 Interest thereon from the date hereof in ten equal annual
 Stalments the first to become due on the 13th day of February
 1827 at which time the interest is to be paid just and on
