Together with all and singular the rights, members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Tho. Cuthbert his heirs and assigns forever. And I hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators To Warrant and forever all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Tho. Cuthbert his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and assigns, & against all and every other person or persons whosoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
