eration of the sum of One Hundred and Fifty dollars to me paid by Baylis.  
J. Earle of the same district in the State aforesaid. Have granted, bargained  
sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release  
unto the said Baylis J. Earle all that Tract or parcel of Land in Greenville  
district on the waters of Enoree being part of a tract conveyed to me by  
one John Edwards containing One Hundred acres more or less having such  
boundaries shape &c as are represented in a plat thereof made by George  
Salmon Esq. for William Sheltow, Bounded by W. Carrolls land by Thomas  
Edward by the tract where Wm Brady now lives, and lying on the road  
from Greenville C.H. to Ashville in St. C. above Brads. Together with  
all and singular the rights, numbers, hereditaments and appurtenances, to  
the said premises, belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining  
to have and to hold all and singular, the premises before mentioned, unto  
the said Baylis J. Earle his heirs, and assigns, forever. And I do hereby bind  
myself my heirs, executors, and administrators, to warrant and forever defend  
all and singular the said premises, unto the said Baylis J. Earle his  
heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every other person  
whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof  
Witness my hand and Seal this Ninth day of November in the Year of our  
Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty Two and in the Forty seventh  
year of the Independence of the United States of America. Signs sealed
