


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Thomas Brummett died by patient bearing date the 3<sup>rd</sup> February 1794. the same being conveyed from the said John Brown to the said John Garland containing in the whole land two hundred and fifty acres more or less together with all and singular the Rights, members & hereditaments and appurtenances belonging or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the land above mentioned unto the said Jeremiah Cleveland his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant & forever defend all the above mentioned land unto the said Jeremiah Cleveland his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant & forever defend all the above mentioned land unto the said Jeremiah Cleveland his heirs and assigns and against myself my heirs & against all and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof in Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 1<sup>st</sup> September 1824. Signed sealed and acknowledged in the presence of Leonard Parngle, John Gower & John Garland.

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State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I Richard Greenville District Young of the district and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of twenty five dollars to me in hand paid by Hiram Young, and also for the love and natural affection I have and bear towards my said nephew Hiram Young have given bargained sold and delivered to the said Hiram a negro boy named Kit to have and to hold to him and his heirs forever, which said negro boy is to remain with, and to be for the exclusive use of my brother and his wife during their lives and at their death to belong fully and completely to the said Hiram upon his paying to his brother John Young one hundred dollars and until that sum be paid the said John Young shall have a full and good claim on the said boy for one hundred dollars Intestemancy whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 18<sup>th</sup> day of February A.D 1825. In presence of William Choice Jr, Richard Goodlett, Richard Young

The word to the said Hiram intimated before signed W.L. Jr

South Carolina Personnally appeared William Choice Jr and after being duly sworn Greenville District makes oath that he saw Richard Young sign seal and acknowledge the written deed of gift to Hiram Young for the uses and purposes therein mentioned and that Richard Goodlett was a subscribing witness to the same with himself sworn to this 18<sup>th</sup> day of February 1825.
