original line thence so original line to a conditional line made between Nichol-
as Darnell & Thomas Young thence so Conditional line to Armstrongs Creek thence
down the Creek to the beginning together with all & singular the right, number,
hereditaments appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise
incident or appertaining to have & promises to have & to hold all & sin-
gular the premises before mentioned unto the sd. Reuben Maston his heirs &
assign forever & I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators to
covenant & for ever defend all & singular the sd premises unto the sd.
Reuben Maston his heirs & assigns a justly myself my heirs & against
