the district of Grunville in the State of South Carolina and who married the repre-
ted daughter of the said Eaton Hawkins deceased called Polly Hawkins for and in
consideration of the sum of fifty dollars to me in hand paid by Jeremiah Cleveland
= land of the district of Grunville and State aforesaid, have bargained sold and
released all my distincttive share of a certain Tract of land when the said Eaton
Hawkins formerly had all the right title and claim that the said
John Ragland is intitled and the intent that my wife Polly has in the said
tract or parcel of land and the part or parcel of land now intended to be
conveyed is one third part of the whole of the Real Estate of the said
Eaton Hawkins deceased. And Where the widow Catherine Hawkins now
lives and I do by these presents grant, bargain and sell all the right title
and interest that my wife has or is intitled to under the last will and
testament of the said Eaton Hawkins deceased I do hereby for ever defend
all and singular the said distincttive share of the said land to the said
Jeremiah Cleveland his heirs and assigns forever from me and my
heirs or executors or administrators to the said Jeremiah Cleveland and his
heirs and assigns forever. And the proceeds of the said land agreeable
to the last will of the said Eaton Hawkins deceased for his uses
and benefit to him and his heirs for ever In witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and seal this thirtieth day of November in the
Year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and twenty seven

of Davis Whitman, Jepse Hawkins ³ John Ragland ³

Hilgore, have granted, bargained, sold & released by these presents
do grant, bargain, sell & release unto the said Benjamin Hilgore all that parcel
of land containing 31 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres more or less situate in Grunville District on Golden Creek
beginning at a wt. Oak Sapling 34.3 n on the N. bank of said Creek a bent one chain
above the Old Machine place & runs N. 52. E. 30 to a forked Red Oak 3x3 x n 119 W 33.50
to a maple 3x0.9m on the Creek then w 62. E. 19. 25 to a Spanish Oak 3x3 x n. then w 39 $\frac{1}{2}$
E 5. 25 to the beginning with privilege to over flow with water two chains above
the last mentioned line & privilege reserved by the said Gunn for himself, his heirs
& assigns to run a fence across said Creek two chains below the last mentioned
line together with all and singular the Right, members, hereditaments & appur-
tenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining
to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned with
privilege unto the said Benjamin Hilgore his heirs and assigns
