doth bargain sell and in plain and open market deliver unto the  
said Hudson Berry senr the following mentioned property four & two  
beds & furniture one barrel mare & colt to have and to hold all  
and singular the said property unto the said Hudson Berry senr his exec-  
utors administrators and assigns for ever provided nevertheless and it  
is expressly agreed between the said parties that if the said John Rice  
his executors or administrators shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid  
unto the said Hudson Berry senr certain attorneys executors administrators  
or assigns the full sum of forty five dollars Eighty seven & a half Cents with  
interest thereon with Equity of Redemption within twelve months  
whereupon thereafter my hand and seal this the 12<sup>th</sup> of January 1828.

I, Nenrod Underwood Sheriff of Grenville District and State aforesaid send  
Greeting; Whereas by virtue of sundry Writs of Fieri Facias issued out of the  
Court of Common Pleas, held for the district of Grenville Justed the first monday  
after the fourth Monday in October in the year of our Lord one thousand  
Eight hundred and twenty five at the suit of Eli Baldwin and others  
to me directed commanding me that of the goods and chattels, lands and ten-  
ments of Newton Bramblett to levy the sum of Two hundred dollars damages  
and costs. I have seized and taken of the lands and tenments of the said Newton  
Bramblett one hundred & forty acres more or less situate and being in the  
in the district of Grenville & State aforesaid Beginning at a note corner near  
Honey Creek thence S. 60. 40. to a Black Oak & thence S. 30 to a conditional Post  
Oak & a gnd an thence a westerly course a conditional line to the River  
cornering on a Black gum just above the Hurican Shoal on Reedy River  
thence a conditional line a gnd an by Newton Bramblett and John  
Dacus. thence up said River to the mouth of Honey Creek thence up said  
bank to the beginning corner originally granted to Francis Baumar &  
Peter Freeman containing one hundred and forty acres more or less  
and where as the said premises with their appurtenances since the seizure
