Examined by me did declare that she does freely voluntarily and with-
-out any Compulsion, duad or fear of any person or persons whom
-soever renounce, release and forever relinquish unto Peter Brynker
my his heirs and assigns all her interest and Estate, and also all her right
and Claim of dower of in or to all and singular a certain tract of land
Supposed to contain one hundred and five acres lying in the district
and State aforesaid on the waters of brushy creek conveyed by the
said Levi Howel to the said Peter Brynker my bearing date the
twenty fifth day of March A.D 1817. Given under my hand
and seal this seventh day of June in the year of our Lord one
thousand Eight hundred and twenty Eight, and fifty second of

-sents that I Levi Stokes of Greenville District in the State aforesaid, in
-comidation of six hundred and fifty dollars to me paid by Hughes
Stokes of Greenville District in the State aforesaid Have granted, bargai-
-ned, sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain, sell
and release, unto the said Hughes Stokes, a certain plantation tract or
parcel of land lying and being the district and State aforesaid
on the South West side of Rudy River containing Two hundred and
forty two acres be the same more or less. Beginning on a black Gum on the
S. W. side of Rudy River running thence S. 62. W. 25. chains to a pine thence
S. 30. E. 84. Chains & fifty links, to a Stake thence N. 60 E. 27. chains & 50 links
to a chestnut on the S. W. bank of the said River thence up the meanders
of the said River to the beginning, being the same that was conveyed to
me by Inman Stokes, by deed bearing date the eighteenth day of January
Eighteen hundred and twenty seven being had thereto will more-
-fully appear. Together with all and singular the rights, members hereditam-
-ents and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise in-
-cident or appertaining to have and to hold, all and singular the
premises before mentioned, unto the said Hughes Stokes, his heirs and
assigns for ever. and I do hereby bind my self & my heirs, Executors and
administrators to warrant and for ever defend, all and singular the
said premises, unto the said Hughes Stokes and his heirs and assigns
against me and my heirs and against every other person or persons
lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof. Witness
my hand and seal this second day of January in the year of our
Lord one thousand Eight hundred and twenty seven and in the fifty
first year of the Independence of the United States of America
