forever and it is hereby declared to be the true meaning and
intent of these presents that the said Doctor Theodore Guidine
his heirs Executors and administrators shall stand seized of the afores-
aid premises in trust for the exclusive benefit use and
advantage of the said Mrs Elizabeth Frances Guidine for
and during her life and and at her death the premises a house
mentioned and described shall rest absolutely in fee in the issue
of the said Mrs Elizabeth Frances Guidine lawfully begotten of
her body as fully and completely as the same has been noted
in me by virtue of my title as purchaser And I the said William
Allston for myself and my heirs Executors administrators and
assigns do covenant by these presents to warrant and for ever
defend the premises a house mentioned and described unto the
said . . . his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns in trust
for the use and purposes aforesaid against me and my heirs
and against every other person or persons claiming or to cla-
im the said premises or any part thereof Witness my hand
and seal at Greenville Court House in the State of South
Carolina this Eighteenth day of August in the year of our
Lord One thousand eight hundred and twenty eight and
in the fifty third year of Sovereignty and Independence of
the United States of America signed sealed acknowledged
and delivered in presence of
