 ton in the State aforesaid the receipt whereof is hereby acknow
 ledged have Granted bargained sold & released & by these
 presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the said James
 May all the tract of land wherein I stately lived containing
 two hundred and seventy five acres more or less being & lying
 in the District of Greenville & State aforesaid on South Tyger
River beginning on a Stake on the East side of said River
 near the mouth of the Beaver dam Creek, Thence up the upper
 line thence N. 5. E with said line to a pine corner thence N. 35.
 E. 31. Ch to a Red oak thence N. 49. W. 44. Ch to a Stake thence
 S. 35. W to a oak thence same course to Tyger River thence down
 the meander of said River to a post oak on the west side of said
 River near the upper Coal or waggon ford thence a straight
 line to a red oak on the west side of said River nearly opposite
 to the mouth of a branch thence to the nearest Part of said
 River thence down the meander of said River to the begining
 it being part of a tract of four hundred & twenty acres
 of Land granted to Jeremiah Dutton the third day of October
 Seventeen hundred & eighty five & the whole of a tract of two hun
 dred acres granted to John Childs for the fifth day of December
