 released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release
 unto the said Abraham Cox a plantation and tract of land
 lying in the State and district aforesaid in Mountain Creek
 waters of Saluda River containing one hundred and thirty three
 acres lie the same more or less Beginning at a pine 3x bound
 running about S. 74 W. 36 to a post oak 3x bounded by Tully
 Battings land thence S 10 E. 51 to a stake 3x bounded by Joseph
 McCulloughs thence N. 16 W. 22 to a post oak 3x cut down
 bounded by Reuben Cox thence N. 10 E. 53 to the beginning corner
 bounded by McCulloughs and Map Seaborns land together with
 all and singular the right number hereditaments and appurte-
 nances to the sd premises belonging or in any wise incident or ap-
 pertaining to have & to hold all and singular the premises
 before mentioned unto the said Abraham Cox his heirs and
 assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Execu-
 tors and administrators to warrant and for ever defend
 all and singular the sd premises unto the sd Abraham Cox his heirs
 and assigns against myself and my heirs and assigns every other
 person whosover lawfully claiming or to claim the same
 or any part thereof Witness my hand seal this twentieth
 day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand
 eight hundred and twenty eight and in the fifty third
 year of the Independence of the United States of
