 that tract or parcel of land containing Nineteen acres and one
 tenth of an acre and being in the aforesaid mentioned State and
 district on small branches of Saluda River and binding on land
 of the said Westfield which said tract of nineteen acres and one tenth
 tenth of an acre be the same more or less is laid out to the said
 David Westfield as follows Beginning at a stone near the said
 Westfield garden and running N. 46. W. 2.62 to a pine tree thence S.
 44° W. 30.20. to a Stake thence up said branch 11.60 to a
 Sweet Gum thence N. 63° E. 35.20. to a black gum thence S. 44. W. 9.70 to the
 beginning including the aforesaid number of acres more
 or less which will more fully appear by a plat hereunto annexed
