a tract of land originally granted to Bailey Connor for 568 acres on
the 5th day of March 1804 and recorded in Grant Book 33 page 105
page 119 beginning on a Stake 34 thence S. 83° E. 4 W. 31 to a Stake 34 thence S. 7°
W. 19 to a Stake 34 thence S. 83° E. 4 to a Hickey 34 thence S. 7° W. 53. 25 to a P. O. 34
thence N. 86° E. 43 to Stake 34 thence to a P. O. 34 thence N. 25. W. 26 to a P. O. 34
thence N. W. 29. 50 to the beginning including one hundred & ninety
acres more or less together with all & singular the Rights members
hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or
in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold
all & singular the said premises unto the said John Whitt
his heirs & assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs
executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and
