Townsend of said district the following property, to wit one negro boy Martin, one negro girl Lucy & her child, to have & to hold all & singular the said property, together with, the future issue & increase of the said negro Lucy unto the said Benj. Townsend his Executors, adm'rs & assigns for ever; provided, nevertheless be it known it is expressly agreed between the said parties that should the said Frances Drby pay and discharge a certain note given by the said Frances with the said Benj. as security to Charles Drby Adm'r of Jas Drby Decd, for upwarrds of
