

Testid the sixth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand
 and eight hundred and Twenty Eight at the suit of Thomas
 Edwards to me directed, Commanding me, that of the goods and chattels
 lands and tenements of Wiley Burns to levy the sum of twenty two
 dollars damages and costs I have seized and taken of the lands and

 the said Writ of Habeas corpus before mentioned have been ex-
 posed to sale at public vendue and purchased by Thomas Edwards
 of the district of Greenville for the sum of twenty five dollars &
 seventy five cents being the highest sum that was bid therefor
 Now know ye that I James McDaniel Sheriff aforesaid
 by virtue of the said Writ of Habeas aforesaid, to me
 directed and delivered as aforesaid, and by virtue of the Statute
 in such case made and provided and for and in consideration
 of the said sum of Twenty five dollars & seventy five cents to
 me in hand paid or secured to to be paid by the said Thom
 as Edwards the receipt and pay ment whereof I do hereby ac-
 knowledge, have granted bargained and sold and by these presents
 do grant, leagaine and sell unto the said Thomas Edwards his
 heirs and assigns for ever the said tract, piece and parcel of land
 with its appurtenances and all the Estate, right, title and interest
 which the said Wiley Burns of Right had, or in or to the same to
 have and to hold the said piece, parcel and tract of land
 with its appurtenances unto the said Thomas Edwards
 his heirs and assigns for ever, as fully and absolutely as the
 said James McDaniel might could, or ought to grant
 leagaine and sell the same, by virtue of the Statute aforesaid
 and the said Writ of Habeas or other wise Instructed
 whereof I the said James McDaniel have hereunto
 set my hand and seal the second day of February in
 the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
