 tors shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the  
 said William Arnold his certain attorney Executors or administra-  
 tors or assigns the full and just sum of one hundred dollars  
 on the twenty fifth day of December next for which sum the  
 said William Arnold holds his note bearing date the Eleventh  
 day of March 1829. Then and in such and at all times
