 River originally granted to John Wood bearing date 1786 repre-
 senting had therunto will give the causes and distances of all
 part of said tract on the south side of said River also one other
 Tract or parcel on the south side of said River beginning at a
 white oak tree in line So. 20 W. 76 Chain to a red oak & thence So. 84 W. 4.
 25 Spanish oak & thence So. 30 W. 10 Ch to a chestnut & thence in
 W. 35 6. to a stake thence N. 8 E. 18 20. to a sassafras & thence So. 82
 C. to the beginning & also one other tract or parcel on the
 No side of the River beginning on a red oak on Joseph Mc-
 Kinney line thence to a white oak on Saluda River thence 2
 or stakes & thence to a white - on land run for Thomas Riser
 thence to the dividing line which was the beginning the whole
 to contain two hundred acres be the same more or less
 Together with all and singular the rights, hereditaments and
 appurtenances to the said premises, belonging or in any
 wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all
 and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said
 John Spriggs his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby by
 myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant
 forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the
 said John Spriggs his heirs and assigns against myself my
 heirs and against every person or persons whomsoever laying
 claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. In
