The State of Mississippi, Whereas I Micajah Pickett Jr. of the State and Franklin County, ³ County aforesaid being a residuary claimant of the land and covenant of Micajah Pickett to his wife Hisannah Pickett of the tenth of January Eighteen hundred and five and wishing to have whole matter closed doth hereby agree that the Court of Equity for Grenville District at Grenville Court House South Carolina doth order that James Pickett do receive the sum of fifteen hundred dollars on the first day of July next with interest thereon from the seventh day of July 1829, for which sum of fifteen hundred dollars & interest the said James Pickett is to hold Cloath and support the said Hisannah Pickett during her natural life which said sum of fifteen hundred shall not be eligible to the said Micajah Pickett Jr. individually but to be deducted from the whole sum of money coming to the legal heirs of the said Micajah Pickett and Hisannah Pickett which said sum of money by the said James Pickett is to hold & keep to his own proper use and benefit for ever as witness my hand and seal this 8th day of September AD 1828 signed sealed and acknowledged in presence of the undersigned for the uses and purposes therein mentioned the date above written —
