 unable to work by sickness or old age then in that case the said
 Kisannah was and is to pay to the said James fifty Cents for
 each week for the boarding and cloathing of said negro man
 Jim during of his life. and also and further the said Kisannah
 was and is to pay the said James for all cloathing or articles of
 any description that he may furnish the said Kisannah with
 during of her life also to pay the said James for all medical aid
 also it was a good between the parties that the said James was
 to keep the accounts of all costs and Expinditures against the
 said Kisannah of every description whatsoever during of the said
 Kisannah life and she was to pay all accounts with interest
 thereon until paid. as Witnesses hereunto we do set our hands
 and seals this 29th day of June in the year of our Lord
 1829.
