these presents that I Francis H Maccloud of Grunville District  
and State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of one dollar to  
me in hand paid by Edmond Waddell, William Robinson and William  
Choice Commissioners of the Streets and Markets in the Town of Grunville  
the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. Have given, granted, bargained,  
sold, released and conveyed and by these presents do give  
grant bargain, sell, release and convey unto the said Commissioners  
and their successors in office all that piece parcel and tract of land  
situated lying and being in the District of Grunville aforesaid  
Beginning at a Stake near a rock and running thence S. 66 E. 8.75  
to a Stake thence N. 34 E. Sixty two feet to a Stake thence N. 44 W. 3.50  
to a Stake on the Spartanburgh Road leading by the Tan Yard and then  
ee 8.39 W. 3.25 along the said Spartanburg Road to the beginning  
corner together with all and singular the rights, members, heredi-  
taments, and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in  
any wise incident or pertaining. To Have and to Hold, all and  
singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Commission-  
ers and their successors in office for ever, in trust for the citizens  
of the Town of Grunville and its vicinity for the sole and exclusive  
use of a Cemetery or Grave yard, to be appropriated entirely  
as a repository for white persons to the exclusion of slaves and  
persons of colour. Provided also that the said Commissioners  
or their successors shall have the power of land a house desir-
