 in order to have a regular Meeting House where a Church may be formed
 am Consideration of the sum of five dollars to me in hand paid
 by James Harper, Spartan Goodlett and James Nolan Esquerry of the
 same district. the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have given
 in granted, alienated and sold and by these presents do give, grant
 Alien and sell to the said James Harper, Spartan Goodlett and
 James Nolan and their successors one and nineteen acres of
 land Situated in Greenville District on Tyger River beginning at
 a pine on the Road and running S. 45 E. 5 ch. 40 links, bounded by
 Gerard land, to a post oak bush corner thence N. 87 E. 5 ch. to a
 Hickory corner thence N. 4 W. three chains to a stone corner, thence S. 87
 W. 3 chain, fifty links, to a stone corner thence N. 4 W. two chains -
 Ninety link, to a black oak corner on the said Road and thence
 S. 69 E. along the said Road one chain and fifty links to the
 beginning corner, as the plat thereof hereunto annexed will fully shew
 and which is a part of this deed to gether with all and singular
 the Rights, manner, hereditaments and appurtenance to the said piece
 of land belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have
 and to Hold to the said James Harper, Spartan Goodlett and James
 Nolan and their succession, in Trust. nevertheless for the use, benefit
 and behoof of the Congregation which may attend at Milford
 Meeting House to be Erected on the said piece of land till a
 regular Baptist Church shall be formed and organized at the
 said Milford Meeting House and sufficiently known in law
 to hold property. then the said James Harper, Spartan Goodlett
 and James Nolan Trustees as aforesaid are to Convey the
 said piece of land with all its appurtenance to such persons
 as the said Church may appoint for that purpose, in
 fee simple for the use of the said Church. In witness
