 of South Tyger River begining at a pine corner near George Underwoods ditch
 and James Goodlets corner running thence N^o. 46 E. 37 chain to a black oak
 Saplin thence S^o. 44 E. 54 chain 57 links to an ash thence S^o. 46 W. 57 chain to a stake
 James Goodlets corner thence N^o. 44 W. 54 chain 57 links to the Beginning containing
 by estimation two hundred acres be the same more or less the same being
 the lower end of a tract of land granted to Ephraim Rose containing three
 hundred acres by patent bearing date the fifteenth day of October 1784 and
 him conveyed to me together with all and singular the rights members
 hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any
 wise appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises
 before mentioned unto the said Wilson Barton and I do hereby bind
 my self my heirs Executors or administrators to warrant and defend
 the aforesaid mentioned premises unto the said Wilson Barton his heirs
 and assigns ever against me and my heirs and against every person
 or persons whomsoever claiming or to claim the same lawfully or any
 part thereof In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
 Seal this 1st of August in the Year of our Lord One thousand eight
