 Eleven hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Simon Lester of the
 district and State aforesaid I have granted bargained sold and re-
 leased unto the said Simon Lester a certain tract or parcel of land lying
 and being in the district and State aforesaid on the south side of said
old Tyger River beginning at a white oak at the bank of the River
 joining land formerly belonging to Julius Nichols deceased running thence
 South to a red oak at the road near the old school house thence said
 road near west course to a stake on said road to the fork leading
 to Daniel Roper old place thence near East course to a chestnut corner
 thence near North to a stake corner on Turpins line thence said line
 Near S.E. to the river at a white oak thence with the meanders of said
 River to J. Blasingame deceased line thence said J. Blasingame line
 as the fence now runs to the River thence said River keeping the
 meanders of the same to the beginning containing two hundred
 and thirty three acres & a half be the same more or less together
 with all and singular the premises within mentioned. I warrant
 & forever defend unto the said Simon Lester his heirs Executors
 or administrators for ever against myself my heirs Execs or adm-
 inistrators or any other person lawfully claiming the same or any
 part thereof as witness I here set my hand & seal this twenty six
 enth day of December 1827.
