 Greenville District - I George Mefunkin of Greenville District
 in the State of South Carolina in consideration of the sum of
 two hundred dollars to me paid by Jeremiah Cleveland
 of the district & State aforesaid. Have granted, bargained
 sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain
 sell and release unto the said Jeremiah Cleveland all that
 tract or parcel of land wherein I now lie beginning at
 on the middle fork of Saluda River at the mouth of a
 ditch running up the ditch to the branch thence with
 the branch of it meanders to where Daniel Mefunkin
 original line crosses the said branch thence a long said
 line to a corner corner on said Cleveland's line
 which he purchased from Daniel Mefunkin Junr.
 thence along the said line that he purchased from Danl.
 Mefunkin Jr. to a large bayou on the bank of the
 River thence with the River as it meanders to the begin
 ning corner it being part of a tract of land written
 to me by my father Danl Mefunkin containing sixty
 acres more or less. Together with all and singular the rights,
 number, habitation, and appurtenances to the premises
 now belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining
 to have and to hold all and singular the premises
 before mentioned, unto the said Jeremiah Cleveland his heirs
 and assigns for ever. And I do hereby bind by self my
 heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend
 all and singular the said Premises unto the said
 Jeremiah Cleveland his heirs and assigns against any
 self heirs and against every person whomsoever
 lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any
 part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this seventh
 day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand
 and eight hundred and twenty nine and in the fifty
 fourth year of the independence of the United States of
 America. Signed sealed and delivered in the presence of
