 to Jenkins Mills & Kimp's old mills. Together with all and sing-
 ular the rights, members hereditaments, and appurtenance, to the
 said premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining
 to have and to hold all and singular the premises before men-
 tioned, unto the said Baptist Church to warrant and for ever, against
 every person lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof
 Witness my hand and seal this Twelfth day of December in the year
 of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and twenty eight and
 in the fifty third year of the Independence of the United States
 of America, signed sealed and delivered in the presence of
 William Green, Hardy Roberts, Robert Hawkins ^{Seal}
 The state of South Carolina, personally appeared before me ^{as} Hardy
 Greenville District, Roberts and made oath that he saw
 the within named Robert Hawkins sign seal and as his act
 and deed deliver the within written deed; and that he with
 William Green witness the execution thereof, sworn before
 me, this first day of February 1830.

 for and in Consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to me in
 hand paid at and before the signing these presents by Burwell Lick
 of the District and State aforesaid Have Granted bargained sold
 and released and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release
 unto the said Burwell Lick a certain Lot of Land in the North
 west Square of the Village of Greenville Known and distinguished
 by its No. being fortyone in said Square Beginning at a Stake on David Canner lot. and
 running thence North 16° E 150 feet. a long a street 40 feet wide to
 a Stake ¹³⁸ near the Buncombe Road thence North 74° West 200 feet
 to a Stake thence South 16° West 150. to a Stake on a corner of
 Lot No 40. sold to David Canner, thence South 74° East 200.
