

South Carolina Do witness know all men by these presents that I James Gill Greenville District, in the State of South Carolina, do hereby constitute and appoint Nathan Berry of the State and district first aforesaid my true and lawful attorney to vind, sell and dispose of all my right and interest in and to a certain invention for the purpose of Cleaning said Cotton pell ented by the United States called Gilliam's Cotton Cleaver within the bounds and limits of the States of Georgia and South Carolina, and hereby empower him to vend and sell the right to construct and use the said machine within the said states, as fully and completely as if I myself were personally present vending and selling the same. In witness whereof I have hitherto set my hand and seal this 30th day of October Eighteen hundred & twenty nine, signed sealed and delivered in presence of us J H Gayce, A Bynum *[Signature]* James Gilliam *[Signature]*

E. 9. 20. to a Stake 3^x thence S. 87. W. 9. 00. to a white oak 3^x thence N. 3. E. 00. 80. links to the beginning Together with all & singular the Rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and so hold all and singular the premises before mentioned to him and his heirs and assigns for ever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the premises before mentioned unto him the said Joel Allison his heirs and assigns in trust for the said Baptist Society
