Whereas in pursuance of an order from the Court of Ordinary for Greenville District at the instance of Mary Estes vs Charles Estes and others for partition for the sale of Land and real Estate of Charles Estes deceased for partition among the heirs of the said Charles Estes deceased after public notice thereof. Now know ye that in Obedience to the said Order of the Court of Ordinary aforesaid I the said James McDaniel Esqr.
