South Carolina. Know all men by these presents that I. Josiah Kilgore  
of Greenville District in the State aforesaid for & in consideration of three  
hundred & fifty dollars have granted, bargained sold & released & by these  
presents do grant, bargain, sell & release unto Mr Bates of Spartanburgh  
district & State aforesaid, all that Tract or parcel of land containing  
230 Acres more or less situate on Elisha Thompsons Broadhead creek  
where Stacks & Weavers now have a Cotton Factory bounded as by  
the deed from John Lucas to me 4<sup>th</sup> Feby 1826. Together with  
all & singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances  
to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertain-  
ing to have and to hold all & singular the premises, above men-  
tioned unto the said Mr Bates his heirs and assigns for ever and  
I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to war-  
ent & forever defend all and singular the aforesaid against  
myself & my heirs Only Witness my hand & seal this 2<sup>d</sup> day of  
March 1830. Signed, sealed & delivered in presence of
