Crowder Greenville District 3 of the State and District aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged; have bargained, sold, released, and confirmed and by these presents do bargain, sell and release unto Samuel Thompson of the State and District above mentioned all that Tract or Tracts of Land wherein the said A.W. Crowder now lives agreeable to the outside lines shown to said Thompson by me in presence of Joseph Green, lying in the District and State above mentioned on Mountain Creek and Kumps branch containing Three hundred and fifty four acres be the same more or less. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances belonging or in any wise appertaining to the same, I have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Samuel Thompson his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Samuel Thompson his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs executors and administrators and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this second day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty and in the fifty fourth year of American Independence.
