 send greeting; Whereas by virtue of a writ of fieri facias issued out of  
 the Court of Common Pleas held for the District of Greenville tested the

 facias aforesaid to me directed and delivered as aforesaid and by vir-  
 tue of the Statute in such case and provided and for and in considerati-  
 on of the said sum of forty dollars to me in hand paid or secured to  
 be paid by the said Lewis H. Dickie the receipt and payment where-  
 of I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by  
 these presents as grant bargain and sell unto the said Lewis H. Dickie  
 his heirs and assigns for ever as fully and absolutely as I the said  
 James McDaniel Sheriff aforesaid might, could, or ought to grant  
 bargain or sell the same by virtue of the Statute aforesaid and the  
 said writ of fieri facias or otherwise in witness whereof I the said
