Know all men by these presents that J. Wardy McBee Lincoln in the State of North Carolina for & in consideration of the sum of one hundred & fifty dollars to me in hand paid by Perry E. Duncan of Greenville District in the State of South Carolina have granted, bargained, sold & released unto the said Perry E. Duncan, a certain piece or lot of land situate near the village of Greenville Court House, begining at a stake near the Buncamle Road on the Avenue leading to the female Academy, & runs thence North 38 West 150 & a half feet to a stake near the buncamle road thence North 21 East 348 feet to a stake on the Avenue leading from the Academy 20 feet from the Academy line thence South 70 East 128 feet to a stake thence South 21 west along the line of the Academy drawn to the beginning containing one acre & 25 poles together with all and singular the rights, members hereditaments & appurtenances to the same belonging, or appertaining. To have & to hold all & singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Perry E. Duncan his heirs & assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant & forever defend all & singular the said premises unto the said Perry E. Duncan his heirs & assigns against myself & my heirs & against every other person or persons whomever lawfully claiming or to claim the same. In witness whereof I have set my hand & seal at Greenville the 29<sup>th</sup> day of May 1830. & in the 54<sup>th</sup> year of our Independence in presence of Samuel Thompson. {
