 J. Vardry McBee of North Carolina. In Consideration of the sum of one
 hundred and six dollars to me in hand paid by Edmond Maddill of
 Greenville District in the State of South Carolina HAVE granted bargained
 & sold. By these presents doth bargain sell & release unto the said Edmond
 Maddill a certain Lot of Land laid down in the Plan of the Villa-
 ge of Greenville being No. 40. in the North West Square of said Village
 Beginning at a stake on Coffee Street & runs thence North 74 West a long Coffee
 Street two hundred feet to a stake thence North 16 East 150 feet to a stake thence
 South 74 East two hundred feet to a stake thence South 16 West 150 feet to the
 beginning Together with all and singular the Rights, members, hereditaments
 & appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise incident or appertai-
 ning TO HAVE and TO HOLD all and singular the premises before mentioned
 unto the said Edmond Maddill his heirs & assigns for ever and I do here-
 by bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant & for ever
 defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Edmond
 Maddill his heirs & assigns against myself & my heirs & against all
 & every person or persons whomsoever Lawfully claiming or to claim the
 Same In Witness Whereof I the said Vardry McBee have hereunto set
 my hand & seal this 6th day of December 1830.
