presents that J. Edmond Waddill of the District of Greenville in the
State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred
dollars to me in hand paid by David Long of the District and State
aforesaid Have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these
presents grant, bargain sell and release unto the said David Long a
certain Lot of Land laid down in McBus plan of the Village of Gre-
enville being No. 40 in the North west square of said Village.

Beginning on a Stake on Coffe street runs thence North 74 West a long Coffe
street Two hundred feet to a Stake thence North 16 East 150 feet to a Stake thence
South 74 East two hundred feet to a Stake thence South 16 West 150 feet to the
beginning. Together with all and singular the rights members imbediments
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise in-
cident or appertaining To Have and To Hold all and singular the prem-
ises before mentioned unto the said David Long his heirs and assigns
for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators
to warrant and for ever defend the said premises unto the said David
Long his heirs and assigns for ever against myself my heirs and against all
and every person or persons whom soever lawfully claiming or to claim the
same or any part thereof. In Witness whereof I the said Edmond
Waddill have hereunto set my hand and seal this Tenth day of Janu-
ary 1831 and in the fifty fifth year of the American Independence —
