I know all men by these Presents that Charles Southulin of the State of South Carolina and Greenville District have this day bargained and sold unto Gershon Ballahan of the State and district aforesaid a certain tract of land containing by Estimation One hundred and fifty Acres be the same more or less for the sum of two hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said Ballahan at or before the sealing and delivering of these presents for which pay ment I the said Charles Southulin do warrant and for ever defend the said land to the said Ballahan and his heirs for ever. The land lying and being on the head of gap Creek water of the North Fork of Saluda River and joining to said Ballahans plantation whereon he lives begining on the path leading to the Glaspery Mountain and running as the path leads to a post oak thence to a Hickory tree crossing the main road on top of the ridge and marked an a black oak tree on to a forked chestnut this a conditional line then to the south line of said Southulins tract on the head branches of Tyger. Thence on the line to said Ballahans land. Together with all and singular the rights and privileges unto the
