share in the said land with the said Jonathan at the death of our brother  
Richard Ward only Jonathan to have twenty dollars per year except the first  
year which is to be 40\$ for supporting him and to hold that claim  
on the land except they can settle in some other way and I do by these  
presents warrant and defend that claim on the land to the said Jonathan  
against every and all of them In witness whereof I have hereunto  
at my hand and seal this 25 February 1830 signed in presence of  
Caswell Barrett John Ward } George Ward Esq.

Grenville District } et al One of the Justices apointed to keep the peace  
in and for the District aforesaid Caswell Barrett and made oath  
that he saw George Ward sign seal and deliver the written deed

it mentioned and that John Ward was a subscribing witness  
with himself to the due Execution of the same. So sworn and

of seven hundred and six dollars and fifty cents to me paid by Nathaniel  
Gaines of Greenville district and State aforesaid have granted bargained sold  
and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the  
the said Nathaniel Gaines all that plantation or tract of land containing  
One hundred and fifty seven acres more or less situate in Greenville District  
lying on Saluda River Beginning on a maple 3<sup>t</sup> on the River running thence  
S. 65° E. 2.50 to a rock 3<sup>t</sup> thence N. 25° E. 28.00 to a hickory 3<sup>t</sup> on mountain Creek  
thence down said Creek 3.00 to a white Oak 3<sup>t</sup> on the opposite side of the Creek  
thence N. 73° E. 20.50 to a small hickory 3<sup>t</sup> thence S. 47° E. 30.00 to a hickory 3<sup>t</sup>  
thence S. 31° W. 44° 50 to a Beach 3<sup>t</sup> on Saluda River bounded by William  
Arnold's land thence up said River to the beginning together with all and  
singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the same  
belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To Have and To  
hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said  
Nathaniel Gaines his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby  
lived my self my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant
