Whereas I, the said Edward Croft, in and by a certain bond or obligation bearing date the twenty fifth day of January in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty one do stand firmly held and bound unto Pickney Hawkins in the penal sum of sixteen hundred dollars, conditioned for the payment of the full and just sum of sixteen hundred dollars in four annual instalments payable at one time three and four year four hundred dollars to be paid each year as in and by the said Bond and Condition thereof reference being therein to had, will more fully appear. Now Know all men that I the said Edward Croft, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Pickney Hawkins according to the Condition of the said Bond, and also in consideration of the further sum of three dollars to me the said Edward Croft in hand well and truly paid
