 grant, bargain sell and release unto the said Peter Cauble a  
 certain tract piece or parcel of land situate in said District on  
 Enore River Containing fifteen acres but the same more or less and  
 hath such four marks &c as follows viz. beginning at a Stake 3<sup>x</sup> on the  
 west bank of Enore River immediately above the bridge where the  
 Butter ford Road crosses thence S. 66 W. 31 Ch. to a small Spr. oak 3x  
 thence S. 78 E. 17 Ch. to a Stake 3<sup>x</sup> thence N. 38 E. 19.50 Ch. to a Stake on the bank  
 of the River thence up the River about one chain to the begining  
 corner together with all and singular the rights, members, impleta-  
 ments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in  
 any wise incident or appertaining. To Have and to Hold all and  
 singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Peter Cauble  
 his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my  
 heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever
