

The State of South Carolina I know all men by these presents that I William E
Blasingame of the district and state aforesaid
In consideration of the sum of Four Thousand dollars to me in hand paid by
Doctor Thomas B Williams of the said State and district the Receipt whereof is here
by acknowledged Have Granted Bargained Sold and released and by these presents
do Grant Bargain Sell and Release unto the said Doctor Thomas B. Williams the three
tracts pieces or parcels of land herein described all situate lying and being
in the Said district of Greenville on the Grove Creek the first tract being one half
of a tract of Land originally granted to Henry Pendleton for Six Hundred
and forty acres and conveyed by Deed to my Father John Blasingame the 27th
February 1799. by John Woodruff and begins at a red oak corner not far from
the Golden Grove Creek and runs thence S. 45° W. Eighty chains to a black oak
corner thence S. 45° E. forty chains to a Walnut tree for a corner on the dividing
line between this tract and Mr Westfield who owns the other half of the original
Survey aforesaid thence N. 45° E. Eighty chains to another Walnut corner on
the said dividing line and thence N. 45° W. forty chains across the Golden
Grove Creek to the begining corner being the upper half of said original
Survey the plat of which is attached to John Woodruff's Deed to my Father
The Second tract of Land hereby conveyed lies also on the said Golden Grove
and contains forty seven acres more or less and begins at Stake on the Bank
of the said Golden Grove Creek and runs thence S. 26° W. 24 ch. 89 links on
J Cleveland's land to a black oak corner thence S. 45° E. 21 ch. 50 on lands
formerly owned by my father in his life time to a stake on said Grove Creek
and thence with the Meanders of the said Creek to the begining Stake corner
and being the same tract that Thomas and Carter Tarrant conveyed to my
Father by deed dated the sixth day of February 1819. to which is attached
a plat of this tract. The third piece or tract of Land conveyed by this deed
lies also on the said Grove Creek and contains four and three fourths acre
more or less and begins at a red oak and runs thence N. 45° W. 12 ch. 24 links
to a posision corner standing on the south bank of a branch bounded
by lands belonging to Silas Holliday thence down said branch to a
white oak standing on the south side of said branch bounded by lands
belonging to Jeremiah Cleveland thence S. 25° W. 8 ch. 50 links to the begining
corner bounded by lands that belonged to my father in his life time
Together with all and singular the rights members Hereditaments and appertain
ances to the said three tracts of Land belonging or in any wise Incident or ap
paining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
unto the said Dr Thomas B Williams his heirs and assigns forever and I do
hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant
and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said
Dr Thomas B. Williams his heirs and assigns against myself and my
heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to
claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal
this nineteenth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand
Eight hundred and thirty two and in the fifty seventh year of the
Independence of the United States of America
