

221 State of South Carolina I know all men by these presents that I David Peden of the Greenville District of the State and district aforesaid in consideration of eight hundred dollars to me paid by John T Peden of the State and district aforesaid hath granted Bargained Sold and released and by these presents do Grant Bargain Sell and Release unto the Said John T Peden a certain parcel of land containing two hundred and thirty four acres more or less Situate in Greenville district and State aforesaid on both sides of the South fork of Rayburns Creek it being apart of a tract 338 acres originally granted to Samuel Peden by Patton bearing date the 1 day of August 1785 and Recorded in Book EEEE page 287 At 3665 Beginning at a post oak 37 Runs N. 68. E. 47. 40 to a stake & thence Due N 41 80 to a black oak 37 thence S 71 W 65 chain to a black oak 37 thence S. 25. E. 42. 25 to the Beginning corner which includes the quantity of land to be conveyed and the said David Peden do grant the same to the above Named John T Peden to have and to hold all and Singularity the rights of the premises above mentioned forever unto him his heirs administrators executors &c from me my heirs administrators executors assigns &c and against all other persons lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof in Testimony Whereof I hereunto set my hand and seal this day of October A.D 1833 & in the Independence of the united States the fifty seventh & fifty eighth
