released and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said H. L.  
Gross all that tract or parcel of Land situated in the District of Greenville on  
the North Side of South Tyger River which I purchased from Edward Waddell  
Beginning on the said River corner and corner of Elizabeth Jenkins Land thence N. 58°  
E. 35. 38. Jenkins Line to a Stake thence N. 29. W. 43. thence S. E. 40. Stump thence N. 40°  
E. 10. thence a Stake thence S. 55. E. 43. 90 to a Black Oak *Name* Hags line thence S.  
35. W. 58. 40 to a Stake on the River thence up the River to the Beginning containing  
by a survey 130 acres together with all and singular the Rights, Members and  
appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or  
appertaining to have and to hold all the said premises to him his Heirs and As-  
signs forever and I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs and Executors to warrant
