



South Carolina Knowall men by these presents That I  
 Greenville District Felix Green of the District aforesaid in the State  
 aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Thirteen Hundred Dollars to me in  
 hand paid by Edmond Maddill of the District in the State aforesaid have  
 granted bargain sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bar-  
 gain, sell and release unto the said Edmond Maddill All that Tract or  
 Plantation of Land in the District aforesaid on the waters of Reedy River  
 containing Two Hundred and Eighty Seven and a half acres more or less  
 lying on both sides of the main Road from Greenville Court House to Ashville  
 North Carolina being the same that was conveyed to me by Hartwell  
 Richards and to him from Miles Gales adjoining Lands on the North by  
 Lands of Mr Bradley and Daniel Simmons on the west by S. H. Green  
 on the South by Pinckney Hawkins and on the East by Lands of James Bennie  
 and having such shapes and marks as are represented by a plat annexed  
 to the deed from H. Richards to me. Together with all and  
 singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said  
 Premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining: To have and to  
 hold all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Edmond  
 Maddill, his Heirs and assigns forever. And I hereby bind myself, Heirs  
 Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend, all and singular  
 the said Premises, unto the said Edmond Maddill his Heirs and assigns  
 against me and my Heirs, and against every person whatsoever, lawfully  
 claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

 Edmond Maddill his Heirs and Assigns, all her interest and Estate, and also all  
 her right and claim of Dower, of in or to all and singular the Premises within
