127 South Carolina - Know all men by these presents that I William Bates of Greenville District in the state aforesaid for and in consideration of Two thousand One hundred & fifteen dollars to me paid, have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto Philip O Lester and Josiah Kilgore One half of 98 acres more or less situated in said District on Rocky Creek of Enoree River beginning at a white oak 3x on the Long Branch & runs N 84 W. 2.50 to P.O. 3, down thence on William Richards line N 5 E. 17.00 to Red Oak 370 ft. on Philip O Lester's Land N 4 W. 36.50 to a Rock & S. 83 W. 35.00 to a Stake thence on John D Smith's line S. 7 E. 14.00 to a Red Oak 3x dead on the south side of Rocky Creek thence down said Creek and the Factory Race at least 10 feet above or south of High Water mark to the head of the race above the Factory thence on William Bates line S. 20 E. 45.00 to a small Holly 31, on the long branch and down said branch to the beginning - also one half of all the machinery preparation of all kind now on the premises - Together with all and singular the right, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining - To Have and To Hold the one half of all and singular the said Premises and Machinery &c. unto the said Philip O Lester and Josiah Kilgore their Heirs & assigns forever And I do bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant & defend all and singular the said premises &c. unto the said Philip O Lester & Josiah Kilgore their Heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming
