<sup>203</sup> The State of South Carolina } Know all men by these presents that I, David Henning of Greenville District and Village of Greenville in the State aforesaid for in consideration of the sum of Five thousand dollars to me in hand paid by Vardry, M<sup>r</sup>. Bee of Lincoln in the State of North Carolina. I have granted, bargained, sold & released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell & release unto the said Vardry, M<sup>r</sup>. Bee the following described Lots, pieces, & parcels of Land, (viz) a certain Lot and houses whereon I now live, in the Village of Greenville Courthouse, known & distinguished in M<sup>r</sup>. Bee's plan of of the said Village by the number seventeen (N<sup>o</sup> 17) in the North East Square of the said Village. Beginning at a stake corner on old boundary street Running thence North fifteen degrees East 120 feet to a stake near a well, thence South seventy four degrees East two hundred and twenty five feet to a stake thence South fifteen degrees West One hundred & twenty feet to a stake thence North Seventy four degrees West two hundred and twenty five feet to the Beginning having been conveyed by Vardry M<sup>r</sup>. Bee to Roger Lovell and from said Lovell to me as of Record will more fully appear - also another Lot in the Village aforesaid known & distinguished in the said plan laid off by Vardry M<sup>r</sup>. Bee as aforesaid in the North East Square of said Village number twenty two (N<sup>o</sup> 22) Beginning in a stake corner on the corner of Lot N<sup>o</sup> 18. Running thence North fifteen degrees East One hundred & twenty feet to the cross street called Coffee street thence South seventy four degrees East two hundred feet to a stake on Spring Street thence South fifteen degrees West One hundred and twenty feet to a stake thence North Seventy four degrees West two hundred feet to the Beginning by Estimation half an acre of land having been conveyed by Vardry M<sup>r</sup>. Bee to Edward Ward, and from said Ward to me as will appear by Record. also a certain tract of land in the District aforesaid whereon my Tan yard is & including the said Tan yard buildings and tools of every description thereto belonging, the Stock of hides &c. Beginning at a Black Gum on the North bank of a small branch near the Spartanburg Road. Running thence South 18 East Six
