South Carolina & I know all men by these presents that I Samuel Greenville District Walker of the district and state aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Four hundred and thirty two Dollars to me paid by Martin H Jones have bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain & sell unto the said Martin H. Jones a plantation or tract of land situate in said district on the North side of Rockey Creek containing One hundred and forty four more or less beginning at a White Oak on the North bank of said Creek N 21 W 28.75 to a Red Oak then on D Sheppards line N 55 1/2 W 18.25. to a Black Oak then S 45 W 26 to a red Oak then S 28 E 47.75 to a Maple on the bank of said Creek thence down the creek to the Beginning Together with all singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Martin H Jones his heirs and assigns and I do here by bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and for ever defend the same unto the said Martin H Jones his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and against every other person whosoever claiming the same or any part thereof
