





Together with all and singular the Rights mullers and hereditaments app-

cents for which I have bargained and sold to the said Fleming ~~an~~ a
bay Mare seven or eight years old and two cows and two yearlings and twenty
barrels of corn and four stacks of fodder and one shuck pea and Shucks
also ten head of Sheep and also eighteen head of Hogs and also three beds and
bedsteads all household furniture and one loom which property I do
warrant and defend to the said G. H. Fleming his heirs and assigns from
my Heirs Executors and Administrators and assigns and against the lawful
claim of any person or persons lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof the
condition of the above obligation is such that if S. Peter Fleming do well and
truly pay the above mentioned sum of One hundred and twenty two dollars
and fifty cents to the above mentioned G. H. Fleming on or before the twenty
-eighth of December 1841 there and in such case the above obligation
to be null and void otherwise to remain in full force in witness whereof
I hereunto set my hand and seal this the 15th December 1839 in the year of our Lord One thousand
and eight hundred and thirty nine sign and delivered in the presence
of Lexington H. Fleming Wm. J. Fleming
