To all to whom these Presents shall come  
I, William M. Goodlett, Sheriff of Greenville District and  
State aforesaid. send Greeting Whereas, by virtue of sundry  
Writs of Habeas Corpus, issued out of the court of Common Pleas  
held for the District of Greenville, tested the eleventh day of Septem-  
ber in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and  
thirty nine at the suit of Jesse Cleveland. Elias Till & others  
tested the 10<sup>th</sup> day of April A.D. 1840) to me directed commanding  
me that of the goods and chattels, lands and tenements of  
Willey Ballou to levy the sum of One Hundred & six dollars  
and seventy five cents. damages and costs. I have seized and  
taken of the lands and tenements of the said Willey Ballou  
all that certain piece parcel and tract of land containing  
Eighty Two acres more or less situated land being in the  
District of Greenville. Among the knobs of Hogback Mountain  
on the waters of Pacolet River. Originally surveyed by James  
Maxwell and Wm Turner. Beginning at a White Oak.  
thence N. 30. E 8 chs 25 links to a Chestnut. thence S. 82. W. 27 chs  
to a Chestnut. thence S. 2. W. 22 chs to a Red Oak. thence  
S. 45. E 16 chs. 15 links to a Chestnut Oak. thence N. 88. E 17 chs  
to a Red Oak. thence N. 43. E 3 chs to a Stake. thence N. 28 W  
9 chs 20 links to a Maple. thence N. 58. W. 4 chs 30 links to a  
Stake. thence N. 30 E 14 chs 50 links to the Beginning white  
Oak. being the same tract of land wherein Defendant  
now lives. And Whereas the said premises with their appur-  
tenances. since the seizure by me made by virtue of the said  
Writs of Habeas Corpus before mentioned have been exposed  
to sale at publick vendue and purchased by Jesse Cleveland  
of the district of Spartanburgh for the sum of Fifty three & 93  
cents dollars being the highest sum that was bid therefor  
Now Know Ye that I William M. Goodlett Sheriff aforesaid  
by virtue of the said Writs of Habeas Corpus to me directed  
and delivered as aforesaid and by virtue of the
